Community Caregivers is a not-for-profit organization, staffed by over 60 caring and trained volunteers who are fulfilling a crucial purpose within our community by providing welcomed support services to over 125 individuals and families. Their services include transportation for doctor



appointments, groceries, hair appointments, etc., friendly visits, home chores, errands, telephone checks, occasional meal and respite for long-term caregivers. The program complements existing public and private resources geared toward assisting our neighbors to remain living independently in their homes for as long as possible.

Says Dupuis, "Home Comfort is enormously grateful for the support we have been given by those in the Lakes Region over the last ten years, and while we have made it a focus to give back to our community in small ways through the years, we'd like to narrow

the effort to significantly and directly benefit a worthy cause. While we continue to endorse and support local non-profits, we've chosen Community Caregivers to partner with in our tenth year.
